Subj: RELOCATE NAVAL CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIVE SERVICE AND
COMPONENT CENTRAL ADJUDICATION FACILITY, WASHINGTON, DC

(b) OPNAVNOTE 5400 of 1 Oct 09

1. Purpose. To approve relocating subject shore activity and component per reference (a).

2. Background. Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS) and component Central Adjudication Facility (DON CAF) are relocating per direction of Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) 2005 to collocate the investigative and adjudication agencies with similar functions of the other military services and the Department of Defense (DOD). The new locations will have a synergistic effect on the investigative and adjudication services within DOD.

3. Organizational Changes. Relocate NCIS and its component DON CAF effective 15 September 2011. The following applies:

The relocation will have no effect upon existing manpower, funding or chain of command for NCIS.


4. Action

a. The Secretary of the Navy will take appropriate action to relocate subject shore activity and component.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will revise the Plain Language Addresses (PLAs) in the Central Directory Component effective 15 September 2011 unless otherwise directed via official correspondence. Correspondence concerning the PLA should be forwarded to Naval Network Warfare Command (NAVNETWARCOM) (Code 312), 255 Amphibious DR, Bldg 1265, NAB, Norfolk, VA 23521-5000 or by calling (757) 417-6720 ext. 1-4. NAVNETWARCOM will coordinate revision of PLAs in the Defense Messaging Service system with applicable Navy Computer and Telecommunications Area Master Station.

c. Director, Navy Staff, Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33), will revise reference (b).

5. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
